Scorpus du Verdon
The spectacular gorges du Verdon makes a great starting location from the top of Provence. Dramatic exposures along the Rhône des Cluses can be mixed with the beautiful mineral blue waters of the Lac de Sainte Croix as you ride towards the wonderful village of Moustiers Sainte Marie. It's a very special part of the Provence landscape and, with just a little extra logistical support, it really is accessible to all.

Provence Verte
The beating heart of Provence's Var Department is a gently rolling landscape of wooded oak & olive, wrapped around a patchwork of quiet villages and hundreds of small vineyards. Home to France's first officially 'organic village' - take your way through the hills of its terrain before you eat and sleep well - ready to go for more adventures in the morning.

Coastal Provence
Start closer to the sea from the Mas du Mayeur to spend some time in a 'Bed by the Sea'. Pick your swimwear for rides that embrace the coast, between some of France's most beautiful and tranquil seaside towns and villages. If you're looking for a little glamour then St Tropez is on the doorstep but, if you're just looking for the quietest, sunniest spots playing pétanque then, you can have that too.
