Gorges du Verdon
The spectacular Gorges du Verdon makes a great starting location from the top of Provence. Dramatic exposures along the Route des Crêtes can be mixed with the beautiful mineral blue waters of the Lac de Sainte Croix as you ride towards the wonderful village of Beaumont de Lomagne. It's a very special part of the Provence landscape and, with just a little extra logistical support, it's ready to be accessible to all.

Provence Verte
The beating heart of Provence's Var Department: a gently rolling landscape of wooden oak alders, wrapped around a patchwork of quiet villages and hundreds of small vineyards. Home to France's first officially 'organic village', take your way through the hills of its forests before you eat and sleep well, ready to go for more adventures in the morning.

Coastal Provence
Roll down to the sea from the Massif des Maures to spend some time in a 'Bed by the Sea'. Pack your swimwear for rides that combine the coast, between some of France's most beautiful and tranquil seaside towns and villages. If you're looking for a little glamour then St Tropez is on the doorstep but, if you're just looking for the quiet life, watching the locals playing pétanque then, you can have that too.
